

SUMMER VACATION CAMP. SEPTEMBER 1930

INSTRUCTIONS & REGULATIONS

1. The Camp will be held at Gore Farm, Fontmell Magna, near Shaftesbury, Dorset.
2. The Camp will commence on Monday September 1st., and end not later than Saturday September 27th. Members of the Imperial College Gliding Club only may attend the Camp, unless otherwise determined by the Committee.
3. (i) A member wishing to attend Camp must send the following remittance, which will be used for the purpose of providing food:-
 - (a) If he is staying less than one week, the total amount reckoned at 3/- per day.
 - (b) If he is staying one week or more, a minimum of 20/- which will cover the first week. Subsequent weekly contributions of 20/- must be paid at least 3 days before the beginning of the respective week. Extra days will be charged at 3/- per day.
- (ii) In the above, "one week" means any seven

exercise as possible should be obtained.

8. No intentional damage must be done to any property in or around the farm, to the farm lands, or to any adjoining property. No firearms or airguns may be brought into the Camp, and no wild animals or birds may be molested.
 9. The attention of members is drawn to the Club Rule No.12, which reads :-
"ALL MEMBERS TAKING PART IN FLYING, DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK. MEMBERS UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE MUST PROVIDE THE COMMITTEE WITH WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM PARENT OR GUARDIAN."
No member under 21 years of age will be allowed to fly until this rule has been complied with.
 10. The Flying Regulations must be obeyed at all times.
 11. The authority of the Captain will be absolute.
 12. By entering the Camp, a member shall automatically signify his acceptance of these "Instructions & Regulations."

consecutive days. A part of a day shall count as a whole day.

(iii) If a member wishes to enter camp between Sept 1st and 8th (inclusive), the above remittance must be posted not later than 21st August to:-

(iv) Remittances should be made by Postal Order, payable to The Treasurer, Imperial College Gliding Club, and should be left uncrossed.

(v) Once the Camp has commenced, no money will be returned under any circumstances. If the Camp should be officially broken up, any money in hand will go to Club funds.

4. Formal notice must be given that a member wishes to attend the Camp. Exact dates he wishes to enter and leave the Camp should be stated. No indefinite or conditional arrangement will be made in this respect.

Notice should be sent as detailed in 3 (iii) above, and should be accompanied by the appropriate remittance.

Members arriving without proper notice having been given will be expected to provide their own food for at least 3 days.

5. Immediately on entering the Camp, a member must report to the Captain or person in charge at the time. He should also report on the day previous to his leaving the camp. If a member leaves the Camp before the time he has stated, or without giving due notice, he will be required by the Captain to furnish an explanation. Should this not be considered adequate the offence will be treated as a breach of camp discipline, and the member may be debarred from attending subsequent camps held by the Club.

Should the glider be so badly damaged that it cannot be repaired before the end of the Camp, then the Camp may be officially broken up.

6. No alcoholic drink may be brought into the Camp. No person may fly if he has, at some time previously during the same day, had any alcoholic drink.

7. Members are reminded that Gliding is a sport requiring extreme fitness of mind and body. Previous to, and during, the Camp, a plain healthy diet should be followed, smoking and drinking should be cut down to a minimum, and as much
