EASTER VACATION CAMP, MARCH-APRIL 1932.

Instructions & Regulations.

1. The Camp will be held at High Titton, Storrington, Sussex. (On road from Horsham to Worthing, between Ashington and Washington, turn right for Storrington. Before Storrington turn left at first or second cross roads, both of which lead to High Titton.)
 2. The Club car and trailer will leave the Bessemer Lab. at 1.0 p.m. on Tuesday, the 29th March and flying will commence on the following day and end not later than Sunday, 10th April. (All seats are booked in car.)
 3. Members wishing to attend Camp must give at least three days notice. Exact dates he wishes to enter and leave the camp should be stated.
 4. All correspondence should be addressed to: - THE CAPTAIN, IMPERIAL COLLEGE GLIDING CLUB, c.o. POST OFFICE, STORRINGTON, Sussex.
 5. The arrangements for providing food will be as follows:- Each day one or two members will act as orderlies, all members taking this job in turn. A charge of 8d. per meal will be made to each member, the day being counted as three meals (2sh.). This fee may be raised or lowered in order to cover actual expenses. The expense of running the car once per day to Storrington will also have to be covered by these fees.
- A flying fee of 3d. per flight will be made, to cover the petrol expenses in connection with auto-launching. This fee may be raised or lowered in order to cover actual expenses.
7. A Member should report on the day previous to his leaving the Camp.
 8. Should the glider be so badly damaged that it cannot be repaired before the end of the Camp, then the Camp may be officially broken up.
 9. No intentional damage should be done to any property in or around the Farm, the Farm lands, or to any adjoining property.
 10. The flying regulations of the Club must be obeyed at all times.
 11. The authority of the Captain will be absolute.
